

Policy for Third Party Advertising

- 1. Any request for advertising should be submitted to Secretariat.
- 2. Any third party (non CoEJ member related) advertising request will be promoted in our Centre **only** by way of placing a sign on the designated notice board at the discretion of the Office bearers.
- 3. Any approved advertising material will have to be signed by Secretariat before being displayed.
- 4. No more than 1 printed advertising material (each for gents and ladies) will be displayed in the notice board.
- 5. No advertising material shall exceed an A3 format in size.
- 6. Advertising material will not be displayed for more than 90 days.
- 7. If an advertiser wishes to display material for more than 90 days, they will have to submit a new request to Secretariat.
- 8. There will be a charge for advertising apart from those from WF or CoEJ. Advertising rates will be agreed by Management Committee and available at the Treasury office.
- 9. All advertising material has to be in accordance with the charitable constitution policy.
- 10. No advertising material shall be contrary to Shariah.
- 11. Anything outside this policy will be at Office Bearers' discretion.
- 12. Any changes to this policy will need to be approved by the Management Committee.
